Procedure for Patient Attendance at Litfield House

We ask patients to follow the procedure below in order to optimise our social distancing measures:

On arriving at Litfield House:

- Please stay in your car or outside the building until 5 minutes before your appointment time
- Enter the building alone unless it is essential to have someone accompanying you to assist you
- Please bring as little as possible into the building such as coats, bags etc
- Please put on a mask before entering the building
- On entering the building please use the hand sanitiser provided. Please do not wear gloves.
- As you enter the building the Litfield receptionist will ask you a few screening questions and take your temperature with a non-contact thermometer
- Tell the receptionist that you are a periodontal patient and proceed through the waiting room and out of the far door. Turn immediately to your left and using the lift proceed to the second floor where our team will greet you
- On arrival on the second floor please use the hand sanitiser provided again and take a seat
- One of our nurses will complete a health questionnaire with you and take your temperature

During your time in the surgery:

- Please note that due to the need to avoid the generation of aerosols, patients are not able to rinse and spit. Where necessary we will use our high volume evacuation systems to remove excess saliva.
- Once the examination / treatment has been completed, you should replace your mask and you will be offered hand sanitiser

On leaving:

- Please ensure that your face mask is on
- Please use the provided sanitiser again before approaching reception
- Return to the ground floor and exit the lift directly into the hallway (this is the same side lift door as you entered the lift on the second floor to leave) and leave the building
